Over the years, I've worked with seniors who were navigating the difficult decision to move to assisted living. Then one day, it became my mom's turn. Like so many older adults, she wanted to stay in the home she loved.

Her experience inspired me to write YaYa's Journey to Assisted Living. A story that offers comfort, understanding, and hope during this transition.

This is how the journey started. When I came home for the holidays, I expected my Mom's life to be the same, but something felt different. She looked thinner, and the house wasn't as tidy as she always kept it.

I was shocked when I opened the oven and found forgotten food that had spoiled weeks ago. She tried so hard to pretend nothing was wrong, but in that moment, I realized she needed help.

Talking with my Mom about moving to assisted living wasn't easy. Even though I had spoken with so many other families, it's not the same when it's your own. It's emotional,

deeply personal, and often met with hesitation or even fear.

However, with patience, empathy, and the right approach, we built trust rather than creating distance.

Here are a few simple ways to begin the conversation:

- Start gently. Ask how daily tasks are going and listen with care.
- Share what you've noticed. Use "I" statements to show concern, not criticism.
- Acknowledge their feelings. Change can be scary. Let them express how they feel.
- Explore options together. Involve them every step of the way.
- Revisit the conversation. Small, ongoing talks build trust and comfort.



After my Mom moved to Assisted Living she loved it. She had a comfortable room, filled with her special memories, and life enriching daily activities each day.
